

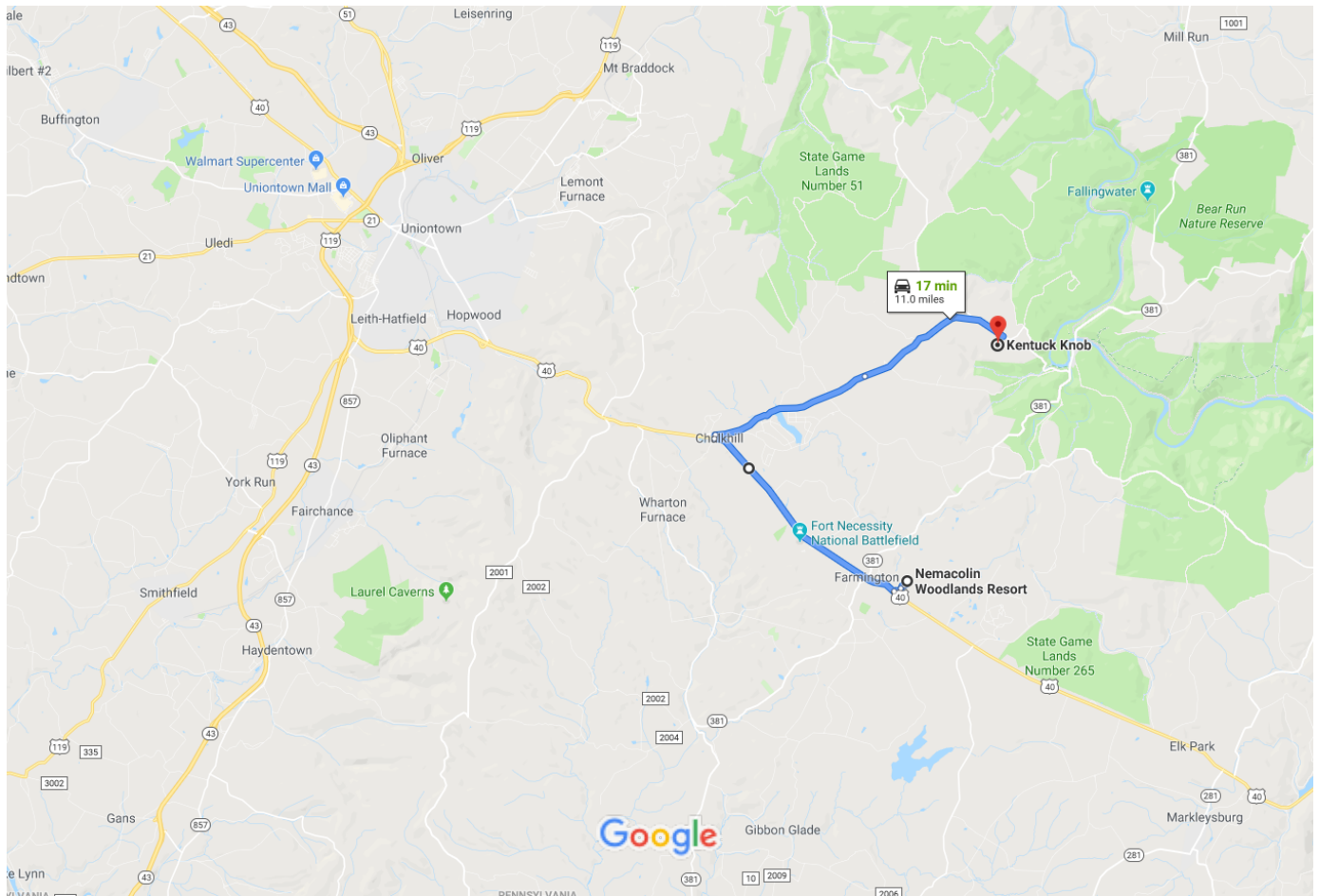


### Nemacolin Woodlands Resort to Kentuck Knob

Drive 11.0 miles, 17 min

As you drive along Route 40 on your left you will see Fort Necessity. The **Battle of Fort Necessity**, took place on July 3, 1754. The engagement, along with the May 28 skirmish known as the Battle of Jumonville Glen, was George Washington's first military experience and the only surrender of his military career.

The Battle of Fort Necessity began the French and Indian War, which later spiraled into the global conflict known as the Seven Years' War. This is the site of the the beginning of the very First WORLD War.
