

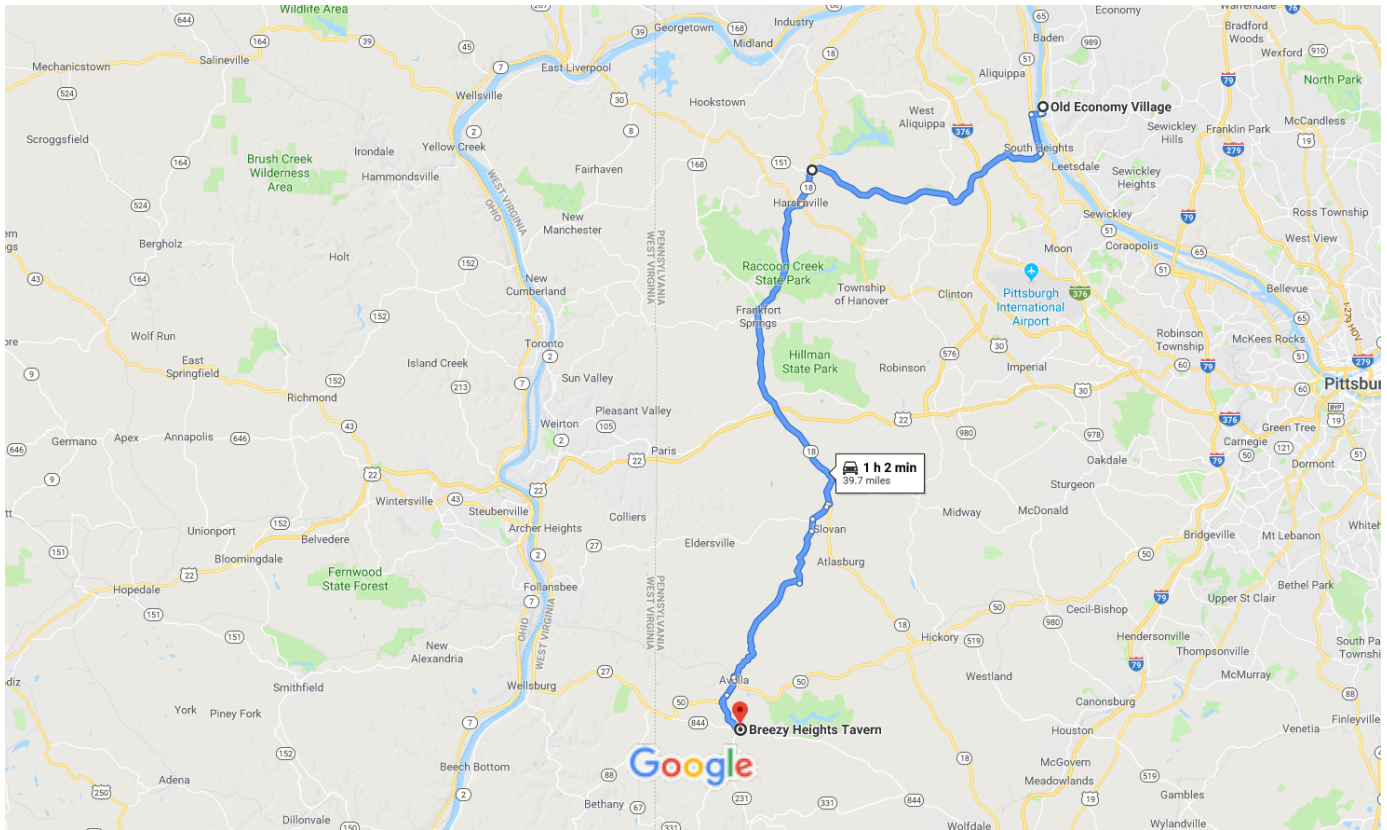


Old Economy Village to Breezy Heights Tavern

Drive 39.7 miles, 1 h 2 min

This drive takes you on Route 151 across the Ohio Rlver and then on Route 18 though Raccoon Creek State Park which is located on the site of a former Victorian era health resort. Frankfort Minerals Springs was the site of a natural mineral spring. Founded by Edward McGinnis in the mid-19th century, he built his resort atop a hill in what is now Raccoon Creek State Park.

You are passing through Appalachian mixed mesophytic forests which is an ecoregion of the temperate broadleaf and mixed forests. These forests are known for their rich diversity of plants and animals, because this area was an unglaciated refugium for many species. This are one of the most biologically diverse temperate forest regions on earth. It has an unusually diverse tree flora, with as many as 30 tree species at a single site including many relics of the ancient forest that once covered North America more widely.
